## 'Little Cemetery On The Prairie'

While trying to think of a story out of the past for this month's column, my husband Harry suggested I write about the cemetery. Harry was born and raised on a farm in the Wellington area not far from the cemetery. Wellington Highland Cemetery is located on a prairie knoll northeast of town.

The old tomb stones and head markers can tell you a lot of history. Some of the old markers were hand made and very interesting. The burial ground is similar to the grave yards or Boot Hills of the old western movies.

In the early days many arrow heads, Indian artifacts and even bones were found in the cemetery. Wild animals such as fox, coyotes, and rabbits lived or roamed in the locality years ago. Today the area is more civilized and there is not much wild life. Some of the family plots still have fences around them for protection against destruction.

We drove to the cemetery recently and it was very peaceful and tranquil. The meadow larks were singing and we could hear the leaves rustle in the silver leaf maple trees. Pretty wild flowers grow on the ground, and artificial flowers were placed on some of the graves.

I noticed many familiar names from the community on the markers. Some of the family names were: Rice, Jones, Farmers, Eatmon, Sinard, Shriner, etc. In the northeast corner among the maple grove is a plot for the Conley family. One of the Conley boys was killed during World War II and was buried there with a military service. When the soldiers fired the twenty-one salute the pheasants just flew up in the air from every direction in the area. I was told there were many pheasants in the area in the 1940's but their population has since diminished.

Some of the old-timers may remember when the town meeting was called in 1906. The mayor appointed a committee to secure land for a cemetery. Frances C. Grable offered the town 8 acres for a cemetery provided the town would fence it, plant trees and use money from the sales of lots for beautifying, improving and caring for the cemetery.

A surveyor was appointed to plot the land into burial lots. Maps of the cemetery show four streets running east and west. There are no street signs but they are named





Elm Dr., Cedar Dr., Pine Dr. and Ash Dr. From north to south there first warranty deed for a cemetery are seven streets called 1st to 7th plot. The next one on record was Street. In the center of the Charles B. Orcutt who paid \$10.00 cemetery is an oval area for a flag for a cemetery deed. A 40' lane was surveyed and work on the road in those days cost \$57.72. The lane led from Highway #1 to the top of the hill which was about a third of a mile. It was a common land between the farms that are owned today by Hilderman and Wagner. Since Interstate 25 was built, this lane is no longer used. The entrance to Highland Cemetery is just a short distance from I-25.

The trees are all gone but in 1906 one hundred shade trees were bought at the total cost of twenty-one Dollars. Water was scarce and the trees died; only a grove of maple trees survived the cold winters and the dry summers.

In 1906 F. C. Grable bought the cemetery. Grass and an irrigation system are in the plans. Lots now for future improvement of the cemetery. Grass and an irrigation system are in the plans. # **Small Cemeteries of Larimer County, Colorado**

Cemeteries and Memorials Located as of January 2005

Compiled by Duane V. And Susan B. Kniebes

The following list of cemeteries and memorials contains the results to date of a joint project of the US Geologic Survey and the Colorado Council of Genealogical Societies. The goal of the project is to pinpoint the location of all cemeteries and individual burials in Colorado. Each location is to be determined by GPS (Global Positioning System) to the nearest second of Latitude and longitude. This establishes a location to about a hundred feet. A name for the site is also important because the information generated by the project will be placed in the GNIS (Geographical Names Information System) data base of the USGS. Sites listed as cemeteries have more than one burial. Single graves are noted as "grave of"

Individuals volunteer to work on each county, with Pat Kemper coordinating the effort. This list is a report by my wife and myself, who volunteered to document Larimer County. The book containing our original data include photographs of the sites, maps showing locations, and historical information about many of the sites.

Most grave sites, except where noted, have some type of marking. The marking may be one or more inscribed headstone but often are only rocks at the head and foot of the grave or, in two cases, an old post or a couple of partial poles with nails showing there once was a wooden cross at the site.

Indian burials are often distinguished by a mound covered with rocks.

*Most of the sites are on private property and are not to be visited without permission of the property owner.* Owners are listed in one of the columns. We would be happy to help get permission for you if you wish to make a visit.
